Recycling On the Go Recycling Ambassador



POSITION DESCRIPTION

An entry level position in the field of sustainability, the Recycling On the Go (ROG) Recycling Ambassador's primary focus is to implement the ROG program at each full service event, working with volunteers to achieve maximum waste diversion and educate the public. This is a physically demanding job with a high satisfaction reward. Recycling Ambassadors report to the Director of Operations or when onsite, ROG Site Supervisors. Position is part-time and seasonal (March – November). Ambassadors will complete training throughout the season to earn a certificate in Event Sustainability upon completion of their first year.

PRIMARY DUTIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Execute assignments from the Director of Operations and Site Supervisors at ROG events
 - Provide waste collection and diversion at special events and outdoor festivals
 - Assist in load-in and set up of waste collection equipment
 - Sort and haul event waste for recycling, compost, and trash
 - Assist in breakdown and load-out of all equipment
 - Represent earthday365 in public
 - Field questions from event attendees about recycling, composting, and waste diversion
 - Direct people to the earthday-365.org website
 - Participate in Training to work towards earning a Certificate in Event Sustainability, awarded at the end of the season.

ATTRIBUTES & SKILLS:

Required:

- Ability to work independently and with a team
- Ability to engage with and work successfully with diverse audiences
- Ability to maintain a positive and professional demeanor while representing earthay365
- Must be able to lift up to 25 pounds and be comfortable outside over uneven terrain for long periods of time standing, bending over, stooping, and twisting repeatedly in varied climatic conditions – rain, shine, heat, cold, etc.
- Proven record of punctuality and reliable transportation with dependable access to digital communication and phone for shift assignments and event information
- Tetanus vaccine required; Covid, Hepatitis A and B vaccines recommended
- Ability to work an 8 hour shift
